THE HEAD OF HOME CONDUCTS THIS BLESSING IN THE PRESENCE OF THE FAMILY BY RECITING

In the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, Amen. Peace to this home and all who dwell here. Lord, we rejoice in the victory of your son over death; by raising from the tomb to new life He gives us new hope and promise.

Bless all the members of this household and surround them with your protection, and may they find comfort and peace in Jesus Christ, the Paschal Lamb, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever, **AMEN**

THE HEAD OF THE HOUSE MAY SPRINKLE THOSE PRESENT AND THE HOME WITH HOLY WATER, DURING THE SPRINKLING THE HEAD OF THE HOUSE MAY SAY: Let this water call to mind our baptism in Christ, who by his death and resurrection redeemed us.

THE HEAD OF THE HOUSE CONCLUDES THE RITE BY SIGNING HIMSELF OR HERSELF WITH THE SIGN OF THE CROSS AND SAYING: May Christ Jesus dwell with us, keep us from all harm, and make us one in mind and heart, now and forever. **AMEN**

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

BAPTISM Our preparation class for prospective parents and godparents is held the first Sunday of Jan., April, July and Oct. at 11:00am at the Church in Minturn. Class is required if you have not taken one in the last three years. At least one godparent must have received the Sacrament of Confirmation. You must be a registered parishioner. If not, a letter from their parish priest is required, verifying they are members in good standing. Our class focuses on the meaning of the sacrament of Baptism and the responsibilities of parents and godparents.

You must pre-register, at St. Patrick's office at 477-0378 x12. **Communal Baptism is celebrated on the 3rd Sunday of the months listed above.** Baptismal preparation classes are also available at St. Clare's-St. Mary's Parish. Call the parish office at 970-926-8980 x 204.

MARRIAGE Engaged couples must contact the Vail Parish Office at least eight months in advance of planned wedding.

RECONCILIATION is available 15 minutes before each weekend Mass. *Or call Fr. Hugh for a private appointment at 477-0378.*

ANOIDING OF THE SICK The hospital is no longer allowed to give names of Catholic patients in the hospital. Please let Father know at Mass on Saturday or Sunday before you enter the hospital, so he can plan to anoint you with the Sacrament of the Sick, extend the Eucharist or call the office at 477-0378.

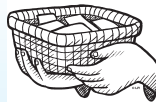
