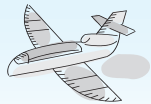

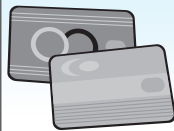
BAPTISM Our preparation class for prospective parents and godparents is held the first Sunday of Jan., April, July and Oct. at 11:00am at the Church in Minturn. Class is required if you have not taken one in the last three years. At least one godparent must have received the Sacrament of Confirmation. You must be a registered parishioner. If not, a letter from their parish priest is required, verifying they are members in good standing. Our class focuses on the meaning of the sacrament of Baptism and the responsibilities of parents and godparents.

You must pre-register, at St. Patrick's office at 477-0378 x12. **Communal Baptism is celebrated on the 3rd Sunday of the months listed above.** Baptismal preparation classes are also available at St. Clare's-St. Mary's Parish. Call the parish office at 970-926-8980 x 204.

MARRIAGE Engaged couples must contact the Vail Parish Office at least eight months in advance of planned wedding.

RECONCILIATION is available 15 minutes before each weekend Mass. Or call Fr. Hugh for a private appointment at 477-0378.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK The hospital is no longer allowed to give names of Catholic patients in the hospital. Please let Father know at Mass on Saturday or Sunday before you enter the hospital, so he can plan to anoint you with the Sacrament of the Sick, extend the Eucharist or call the office at 477-0378.

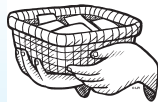
As Jesus fasted 40 days in the desert, the Church traditionally fasts during Lent. A form of bodily prayer, fasting and abstinence in union with other Christians reminds us of our utter dependence on and love for God. A gesture of repentance, fasting is symbolic of a change of heart as we turn away from sin and live in fidelity to the Gospel.

REGULATIONS Fasting: ages 18-59 fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday limiting themselves to one full meal and two smaller meals each day. No snacking between meals. **ABSTINENCE** Catholics age 14 and older abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all Fridays in Lent.
