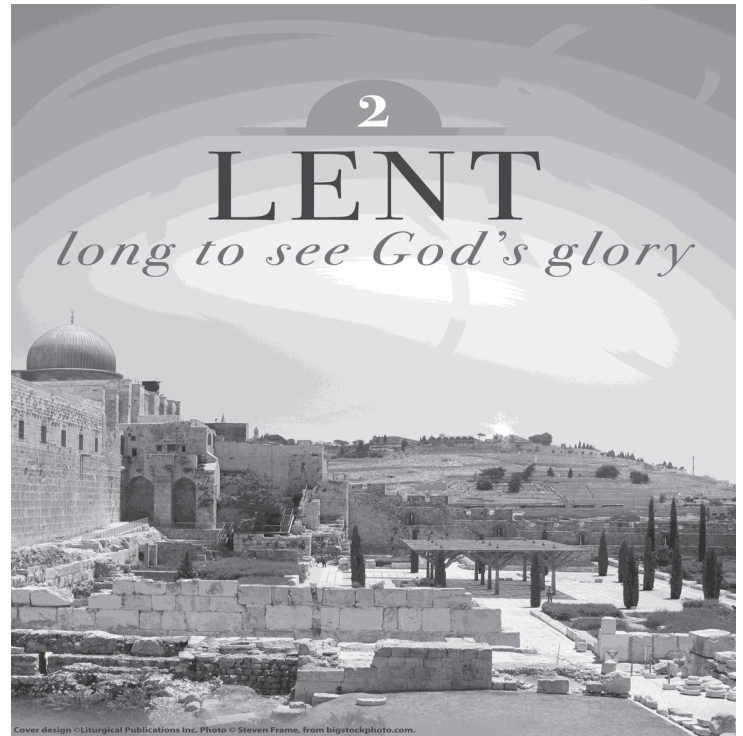

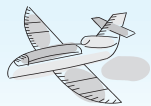

This weekend we will be taking up a second collection. Latin America needs help in sustaining the faith, and Central and Eastern Europe in rebuilding the faith.



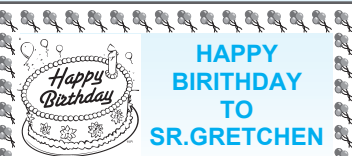

As Jesus fasted 40 days in the desert, the Church traditionally fasts during Lent. A form of bodily prayer, fasting and abstinence in union with other Christians reminds us of our utter dependence on and love for God. A gesture of repentance, fasting is symbolic of a change of heart as we turn away from sin and live in fidelity to the Gospel.

REGULATIONS Fasting: ages 18-59 fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday limiting themselves to one full meal and two smaller meals each day. No snacking between meals. **ABSTINENCE** Catholics age 14 and older abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all Fridays in Lent.

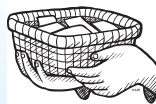
